After the battle at James Island, South Carolina, in 1862, Major Sissons of the 3rd Rhode Island and three other Masons approached the Southern lines under a flag of truce. Major Sissons remarked to the Southern officer who approached, "I suppose by the tools you carry I have the honor of meeting a Craftsman, as well as an enemy in war?"

The Confederate officer replied, "You do, and I am happy to meet you as such." He sent for some of his fellow Masons. Together, they "cracked a bottle of wine and drank to the health of the Craftsman, whether in peace or in war."
